

The community of Sherwood, Oregon, has not built a new high school for over 50 years. In 2016 they passed a bond for the construction of a new, state of the art campus on 83 acres. The new Sherwood High School will be 342,131 square feet and will initially hold 2,000 students with the ability to accommodate future growth, up to 2,400 students. This alleviates overcrowding while keeping Sherwood a one-high school community. The campus will include a performing arts center, science and technology classrooms, multiple gymnasiums, seven sports fields and a football complex.
